

Cadet uniform information

Cadets' first set of blues (dress uniform) are provided as part of membership. Sizes run small – it is recommended to order *at least* one size larger.

BDUs (Battle Dress Uniforms – commonly known as fatigues) are provided free at the squadron level, with the exception of combat boots.

Belts, covers (hats), patches and nametags can be ordered through the Civil Air Patrol Store by Vanguard.mil online.

Once a cadet has sent in their membership application, it is recommended they order their name tape, reverse flag, Virginia Wing patch and Civil Air Patrol tape from Vanguard right away and then ask the cadet supply officer for a sizing chart for BDUs.

Many cadets purchase black combat boots locally at Super Shoes. A plain black or brown t-shirt without pocket is worn under BDUs
